

CHM 104 Homework:

A list of suggested homework problems is provided below. The homework is not graded, but it is not surprising that doing homework usually improves quiz/test/exam scores.

Note that in our textbook that chapter number always precedes the problem number. So Problem 14.3 is problem 3 in chapter 14. The list below gives the chapter number in the first column and three lists of problems in the other columns.

Sample Problems and Study Checks: As you read each chapter read each sample problem and its answer. Then try working the Study Check. You may check your answer with the list of answers at the end of each chapter.

In Chapter Questions and Problems: When you reach the end of each section of a chapter, you will find a group of “Questions and Problems”. Work the assigned problems to reinforce your understanding of this material before going on to read the next section of the chapter. The answers for the odd numbered questions are at the end of each chapter.

End of Chapter Questions and Problems: When you finish reading an entire chapter, work the assigned “Additional Questions and Problems” found at the end of each chapter. The sooner the better while the chapter is still fresh on your mind.
